Thank you for your interest in joining the Jus' Sail Youth Training Programme. This programme is designed to help you gain skills, internationally recognised certifications, work experience and ultimate goal of entry into the workplace. By being accepted on to our programme and giving 100% to your personal development and showing willingness to step outside of your comfort zone on the programme you are taking responsibility for your future career path. When you give 100% Jus' Sail will give 100% backing to you as you move forward.

Acceptance onto the programme is competitive. To be considered onto the course you first need to fill out this application form to **the very best of your ability**, return it to us for evaluation and, if suitable, you will be invited to an interview, at which you will have the opportunity to impress us with your passion and commitment for taking your life forward through your full participation on this programme and ask any questions that you may have about what the programme entails.

Some basic points for consideration -

1. The programme is all or nothing, you commit to attend EVERY session, this may be 6 days a week for up to 6 weeks including work experience. If you cannot commit to 100% attendance you cannot be accepted on to the course.
2. This is a physically as well as mentally demanding programme. For instance you will be expected to learn to swim, being taught to swim is part of our programme, but you must be willing to get in the water and learn, to be accepted on the programme.
3. To be eligible for the programme you must be presently out of work and not in education.
4. The programme is free for you to attend, we cover your transport, lunch and all costs to allow you to undertake the programme, all you have to do is give 100% of yourself, no money from you is required.
5. The age range for the programme is 18-25. Applications outside of this range may be considered on a case by case basis.
6. You must have a valid St Lucian ID card, our sailing voyage may take you out of St Lucia to visit other islands, you must therefore have a Passport OR valid ID card for immigration purposes.
7. You need to have access to a computer or smartphone, if this is a problem you must inform us.
8. Jus' Sail is here to help those who are prepared to help themselves by giving all they have to their personal development, time wasters and bad attitudes are not welcome and will not be tolerated.
